## Key Takeaways:

The diversity and inclusion topic in the workplace have increasingly become a key topic of discussion in the Gulf Region over the past few years, driven by the need to increase regional and global competitiveness. However, while there are discussions in this area, the true value is yet to be realised as most businesses are yet to understand and identify the best way forward on how to enhance corporate governance capabilities in a cost-effective manner.

Amira shared with the students at University of Bahrain the differences between diversity and inclusion in terms of terminology, shed light on what the different unconscious gender biases are and the current framework and the D&I initiatives currently taking place at Schneider.

Amira ended the session with introducing Schneider's internship program launching in May-June 2022 across the Gulf Region with a call of action for all the students to apply in the relevant field.

#### Key Outcome:

Out of the 90 respondents on the post-evaluation survey, 65% of the respondents reported that they are very satisfied with the overall event including the speaker, content delivered, and knowledge learned.
